1. New horizon2020 calls

There are 4 themes for the calls. ASP will collaborate on these calls.

2. Input to Year of Polar prediction (YOPP) from ASP. We will add our atmospheric projects to YOPP. Søren will contact Kirstin Werner from AWI with input.

3. ASP homepage update for associate members

Søren and Peter will make a list of themes that would be valuable to link to from the ASP homepage to the associate members.

4. BBOS upcoming meeting

The Baffin Bay Observing System meeting in Ottawa is approaching. More than 65 have accepted the invitation.

5. There will be a follow up on the BBOS meeting

Danish and Greenlandic institutions will have a follow up meeting to discuss how to participate more closely in the BBOS. Meeting will be held in Denmark 19-20 April.

6. ESFRI infrastructure

We will use the momentum from the BBOS and the Danish/Greenlandic meeting to go for a large European infrastructure proposal later this summer. Deadline medium August.

7. Update on CERC proposal

Process runs as planned. We have now 7 candidates. The CERC will be highly integrated with ASP and the BBOS.

8. DRDC proposal

The UM group has submitted a proposal to DRDC together with University of Laval. The project will support the BBOS.

9. Update on the Pitsiuluq Commission in the North water – Science assessment meeting in Copenhagen Nov 22-24. This will fit very nicely into the CERC, ASP activities and the BBOS focus.

10. ASP has accepted to join a SVALGREEN proposal with UNIS on Svalbard to increase collaboration on education courses between Greenland (St Nord) and Svalbard (UNIS).
