1. Cargo in Loneyarbyen

Most cargo has arrived at Pole Position Logistics in Longyearbyen. The Sea-Bird CTD shipped from the US was supposed to arrive at Pole Position by March 31, though was delivered to a different address in Longyearbyen. Kunuk will try to locate while there.
