Round table:

AU: Continuing education in Greenland collaboration between GINR and AU in 2022. GIOS autonomous systems still transmit data from the field using only solar and wind energy sources.

KU: East Grip starting up slowly - hope to get to the field. The camp is drowning in snow. Working on science program to organise overwintering in the NOW.

Joint Laboratory activities:

Inter comparison between laboratories has started. Shipping problems. Karley will hold on samples and update the teams with the next step. Looking into costs of dry shippers.
