Overview of upcoming calls of common interest in ASP. Bring an idea of the upcoming calls (EU and others) to the meeting and let's discuss consortiums and writing plans.

AU brought up an idea for joint call expected out in 2024.
IDEA: HORIZON-CL6-ZERO POLLUTION: Tackling human and climate change induced pollution in the Arctic.

Should we continue ASP in its current formate? It is good for networking and joint proposal writing, joint paper writing, but do we need dedicated joint ASP campaigns again? Participate in international organisation of an "Arctic science only" meeting (without politics).?

ASP annual meeting (2-3 Nov) & Nansen legacy meeting (1-3 Nov) - is planned the same time. We will try to move the annual ASP meeting to Bergen in connection to the Nansen Legacy meeting to reduce our carbon foodprint. Plan is to start Sunday 30 Oct with a dinner together. Meet all Monday 31 Oct. Wrap up Tuesday 1 Nov just before the Nansen Legacy meeting.

KU: East Grip project field work up and going. Eastgrip.org

UM: Working on the CFREF, Transarctic and CFI proposal. Cruises in Hudson and James Bay. Trip to Müllers cap was successful.

UL: Amundson leaves end of August for Baffin Bay studies (2 mo). Dry dog going well. Shiptime for Lindcoln sea postponed to 2023-24.

AU: Preparing for upcoming field work in Greenland (East and west Greenland).

DFO: Canada marine conservation of oceans - marine protected areas. Focus on the eastern side of Canada (Hudson Bay, Baffin Bay, Landcaster sound and NOW). Reaching out to ASP partners for collaboration. Seak partnership on sample platforms, vessels etc. Hiring a lot of new people to join the work. Regular programs are up and running also.

AWI: Most cruises are running, including Svalbard and Greenland.

Joint Laboratory activities:

Everyone got the samples for Chl samples inter-comparison of lab analysis
